

# AN ANALYSIS OF THE MAIN CHARACTER OF PATTY JENKIN'S WONDER WOMAN (2017) MOVIE : A PSYCHOANALYTIC APPROACH

This study aims to determine, analyze, and describe the character and personality of the main character in the movie entitled "wonder woman" by focusing on the structure of the personality of the id, ego and super ego. This research analyzes the personality of Diana Prince as a main character of the Wonder Woman movie using Sigmund Freud's theory. This research uses a qualitative descriptive research method because the data taken come from movie scripts and movie video. The results of this study are the main character named Diana Prince has an id personality which is based on innate instincts from birth, the ego structure of Diana Prince's personality in carrying out actions according to the norms applied in society. Furthermore, the super ego shown in Diana Prince with her concern for the people around her. The personality that often appears in Diana Prince is the superego that makes her a woman by making many good contributions to be a hero in saving the world.*

## INTRODUCTION

Literary work is a virtual world structure, it means that reality in literature are imaginary realities that is not identical to the realities of the real world, the literary works though virtual, but still refer to the realities within the real word (Noor, 2009:13). As a reflection of life, it does not mean that literary work is a description of life, but is the author's opinion about the whole of life. Literary work is the truth according to the ideal of the writer (Noor, 2009: 11). When talking about literary work, many people are more interested in studying and analyzing the literary work like novel, short story, or song, whereas there is other literary work which also contains a variety of thinks which could have been even more special, one of them is movie.

Endraswara in Minderop (2016:2) states that research on literary psychology has the important role in understanding literature is due to certain advantages like: first, the importance of literary psychology to examine more deeply the aspects of representation; second, with this approach it can give a feedback to writer on care issues developed.

Literary works containing structural elements are a design framework that brings together various elements of movie and presents the mindset of the filmmaker. Structure exists in all forms of art. In the movie, actions and ideas into one unified whole (Shintiani, 2011: 24).

Every movie has a story, it is impossible to escape from the narrative element and every story must have elements such as characters, problems, conflicts, location, time, and others.

Literature and psychology are closely related, indirectly and functionally. Indirect link, because both literature and psychology have the same object, namely human life. Thus, it can be interpreted that literature is unable to escape from the psychic aspect. Literary psychology also views literature as the result of the creativity of the writer who use language, which is perpetuated for aesthetic purposes. Literature is the result of an expression of the soul of the writer in which the psychological atmosphere of the writer is felt, both the atmosphere of thought and the atmosphere of emotional feeling (Endraswara, 2008: 86). Sigmund Freud's theory describes personality into three main structures, namely, Id, Ego and one Superego that are related to each other and form a totality (Alwison, 2009: 17).

In addition to novels, poetry, short stories, and drama, literary works also include movie. Many movies have been circulating to date, with different types, content, meaning and stuff. According to Makarim (2009), the explanation that movies are means of communication, besides radio networks, television and telecommunication. The movies carry communication messages to show on the audience, according to what the director wants to give whether in drama, horror, comedy and action.

Character is a real portrait of someone, good or bad, what to do when no one else does notice it, a collection of behaviors when they appeared in public or our own being strung together consistently in life, repeated patterns of good or bad behavior will get even worse strengthening a character (Kandani, 2010:186). So that thinking and behaving become a characteristic typical individual to live and work together, both within the sphere families, communities, nations and states, good character individuals are individuals who can make decisions and be prepared to account for every outcome of his decisions is said to be a character.

Wonder woman movie is the United States superhero movie of 2017. It was 141 minutes of movie directed by Patty Jenkins. Wonder woman movie is included in popular movie in countries including Indonesia. Wonder woman here tells the story of a woman who went on an adventure to destroy the evils of the world. Wonder woman's Diana Prince is the lead actress, princess. Diana is someone who behaves decisively and courageously the people around her are involved in the eradication of crime.

The Writer interested in analyzed this movie because the story in the movie is giving the lesson that every woman has the right to women's lives, such as: equality of rights, distinction the treatment, the violence, the women's work force. The writer is interested in providing information that a gender-perspective education is intended with that education brings to bear similarity, attention, and treatment of students, between women and men.

There are several elements in this movie that can be analyzed characteristics such as grooves, themes, conflicts, characters, traits, character descriptions, perspectives and figures of speech. However, the writer only focuses on character analysis based on the psychological theory in Wonder Woman, and the influence of the wonder woman character on other characters. The writer would like to describe a character of the main character that is presented by Petty Jenkins in wonder woman movies

## **METHOD**

This study used a descriptive qualitative design. The data is presented by describing the character Diana Prince as the main character in the movie. The approach used in this research

is qualitative. In qualitative studies, the literature serves a different purpose. Qualitative is a type of approach that refers to an understanding of what is subject to research subjects (behavior, perceptions, actions, etc.), (Mukhtar,2013:10). Qualitative descriptive research method is a method used by researchers to find knowledge or theory of research at a certain time. Qualitative descriptive research method is the type of research used is descriptive. The instrument of the research there are:

1. Movie video

The movie video is a medium to find the data that will be analyzed through the viewing video from the wonder woman movie.

2. Movie script

The movie script is the written text of a movie which includes instructions for the actors and directions for filming (Encyclopedia Britannica, 2012), this research used a movie script written by Allan Heinberg and Geoff Johns. The instrument that is used in collecting and analyzing the data is movie script of Wonder Woman that is obtained from the video.

3. Analytical sheet

The analytical sheet was a tool to make the data based on the script movie of Wonder Woman and the video of Wonder Woman movie.

## RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

### 1. The Main Character of Wonder Woman Movie Seen from Psychological Literature Theory

The characterization is the placement of the characters with the character or certain characters in a story. Based on the research results, the main character in this movie is Diana Prince whose storytelling is prioritized. She is the character who is told the most, both as the perpetrator of the incident or the one who was affected by the incident. Another reason why the writer chooses Diana Prince as the main character because she herself is the most told character and is always in touch with other characters, she really determines the development of the story plot. The characterization of Diana Prince is so complex that it is difficult to predict. Character presenting by the writer is depicted through the character's speech, behavior, or behavior which can be seen from the character's narrative, dialogue, or monologue. The figures of Diana Prince are stubborn, worry, reckless, prejudice, easy to get along, care, dare to admit mistake, helpful, friendly, willing to sacrifice. The following is a description of the characterization of Diana Prince in the Wonder Woman Movie.

#### a. *Id*

Id is the basic character of a character which is used as a reference to distinguish a character created by the writer. The beginning of the character always acts following the Id who is completely in a trance based on pleasures that are more selfish. Hence, the Id in movie serves to shape the character of each character, with character can be known in detail the characteristics of each character.

1. **Stubborn**

Diana Prince is a character with a very strong Id. The id aspect contained in the character Diana Prince is described as someone who is full of desire in her. Desires that originally only

wanted to practice turned into other desires that ended up breaking rules, nature, and norms. This can be seen in the following dialog.

Id personality structure can be seen from how Diana Prince wants to fulfill her desire in training for war with Aunty without considering the consequences that can harm others or yourself so that they violate the norms and values that apply in the surrounding community.

The other Diana Prince expression which shows that Diana has stubborn is in the following expression.

The id structure shown by Diana Prince is to prioritize self-pleasure so as not to care about other people.

## 2. Reckless

Reckless is the attitude or action of someone who does not think about the consequences of his actions. If uncontrolled, recklessness can harm both yourself and others. Based on this definition, reckless character is included in the id personality structure. The reckless character of Diana Prince seen from her actions when Diana Prince wanted to show her the way out of the island to find Ares. This is as shown in the following dialog.

### 3. Prejudice

Prejudice is a prejudice that thinks everything is bad but the truth is not yet known. Here Prince Diana's prejudiced attitude towards Sammer, Diana Prince thinks badly that Sammer wants something from Diana and Steve.

### **b. Ego**

Ego personality structure lies between the Id and the Superego. Like the Id, the ego also loves pleasure and resists discomfort. But the Ego considers doing something while it does not hurt him.

#### **1) Easy to get along**

Easy to get along is the character of someone who is easy to get along and socialize with the community. Diana Prince is easy to get along with, it can be seen from her friendly attitude towards strangers. It is like a quote:

Attention is not only to parents, family, friends but can also be shown to new people. In this case Diana Prince pays attention to people she just met. This can be seen from the quote as follows:

### **c. Super Ego**

The superego is a related moral component of personality with the standard of community norms regarding good and bad, right and wrong. Through life experiences, individuals internalize various social norms or accept certain moral principles, then require the individual concerned to live according to these norms. Diana Prince personality in the Wonder

Woman movie is influenced by Superego. The results of the Superego personality analysis described in the following dialog.

### 1. Dare to Admit Mistake

Dare to admit mistakes is the character of the responsibility that is on a person to admit mistakes that have been done by her. The attitude shown by Diana Prince includes people who dare to admit their own mistakes, this attitude is shown as follows:

### 2. Helpful

Super Ego refers to morality in personality. It is the same with the "conscience" which recognizes good and bad values. Super Ego serves as a layer that rejects anything that violates moral principles. The following is an excerpt from the dialogue related to the Super Ego:

### 3. Friendly

Friendly is a quality of humility towards others, reflected in comfort and kind words. This humble nature can be said as the Superego which awakens the individual to behave well (friendly) to all humans. Like Diana Prince friendly personality shown in the next quote:

This friendly attitude shows that Diana Prince has a super ego personality structure.

### 4. Willing to Sacrifice

Willing to sacrifice is an action that helps others without expecting an imbalance and is willing to give something sincere. Implementing applicable norms and social manners. Developing awareness to be willing to sacrifice for others, this action is included in the personality of the Superego.

## CONCLUSION

In this study the writer revealed the character that exists in Diana Prince by using the Sigmund Freud theory which is dominated by id, ego, and super ego. where someone who is in the personality structure who is known through the actions and speech of the Diana Prince is actions and speech apart from being a characteristic of personality, she can also influence other characters by how conveying and acting other characters can support, herself is a force of strength from a person or object that can change a person's views, beliefs, opinions, and thoughts so that they believe in what is said or about that object.

The results of the research on the Wonder Woman movie showed that Diana is a complex character. Diana character as the main character has the following positive characteristics: easy to get along, dare to admit mistakes, helpful, friendly and willing to sacrifice while the negative characters that exist in Diana's character are: stubborn, worry reckless, prejudice. From research on the Wonder Woman movie, it was found that the ego that often plays a role makes Diana's character as a woman who thinks rationally because in dealing with various problems, she still thinks objectively. The id in Diana which acts based on basic instincts also affects Diana psyche, sometimes she does not think before taking action. The super ego limits every action that Diana takes or controls a character's self.

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
